Customer Service Manual

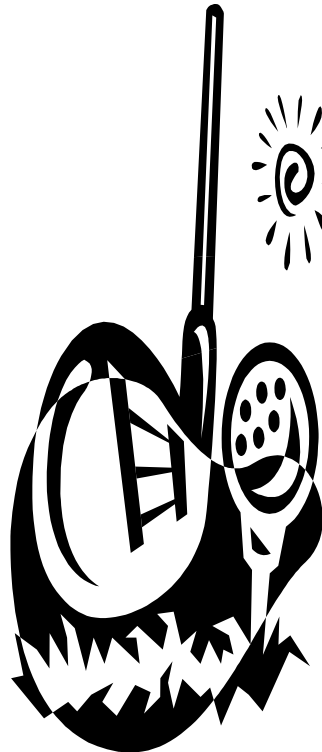
A committee is working to develop a manual to provide area businesses a foundation for employee training. The manual will feature phone etiquette, appearance and dress, communication, as well as, area attractions.
