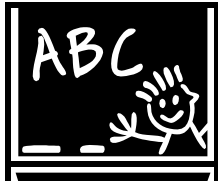

On Thursday, April 27 at 6:00 p.m. in the Middle School Auditorium, Dr. William L. Bainbridge, President and CEO of SchoolMatch, will present the results of the SchoolMatch Audit of Educational Effectiveness for the Carroll County School District.

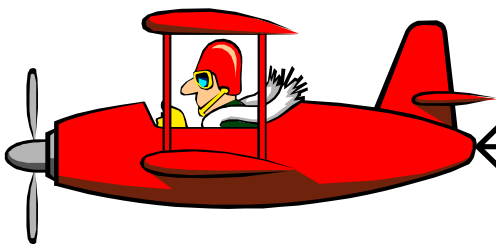
With a single-minded focus on helping the Carroll County School System to become one of the best school systems in the state of Kentucky, the Carroll County Board of Education and the Carroll County Community Development Corporation retained the national educational consulting service, SchoolMatch, to conduct a "Fair Compare Analysis" of Carroll County Schools. This

process analyzed the educational effectiveness of the Carroll County School System compared to school systems from across the country with similar student populations in terms of demographic characteristics, socioeconomic factors, and resource availability.

After months of collecting and analyzing data, visiting Carroll County Schools, and talking with school and community leaders about education in Carroll County, SchoolMatch has completed its final report. Dr. Bainbridge's presentation will highlight the many outstanding achievements that the Carroll County School

System has made, offer recommendations to help realize even further improvement, and answer questions about education in Carroll County.

Education is perhaps the most important resource that we offer here in Carroll County. The Carroll County School System, its administrators, teachers, parents and volunteers are to be commended for the steps they have taken and are taking to offer world-class opportunities to our children. Here's hoping that you will be able to join us on September 2, 2006 at the beautiful General Butler State Park Resort.

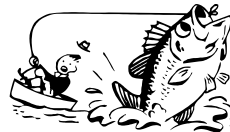

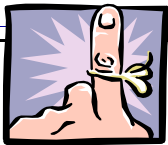
