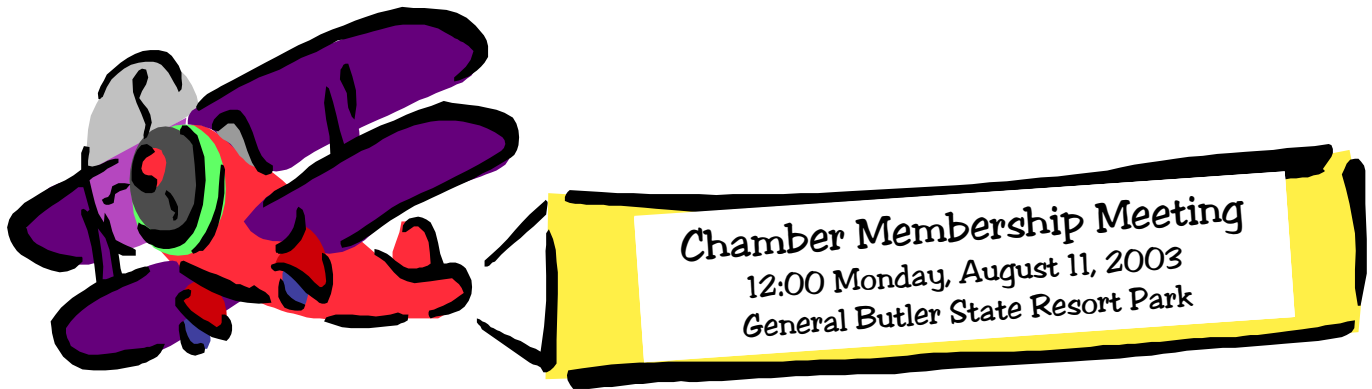

Jefferson Community College - Carrollton Campus Receives Grant for Adult Education Programs

Jefferson Community College Carrollton Campus has received a grant from the Kentucky Department of Adult Education and Literacy to launch an adult education and family literacy program. The program will be based at the college's campus at 324 Main Street in Carrollton and will provide coursework in adult basic education, GED, English as a second language and workforce skills training. Adult learners will be able to hone skills

in reading, math & computer literacy and advance to GED and even college level coursework. The region's employers will have access to on-site education and skills training programs for their employees. The grant will allow the campus to hire an adult education instructor, family literacy instructor, program director and administrative support. The program is also expected to be a boon to area companies who face short-

ages of qualified workers. "This program will allow people to start with basic skills, such as reading, and work one-on-one with literacy tutors to develop those skills," said Susan Carlisle, director of JCC'S Carrollton Campus. The college hopes the program will serve as a model for its other campuses and for other Community Colleges. For more information please call 502-732-4846.



SENIOR EVENT "A Big Birthday Bash"

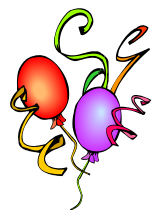
